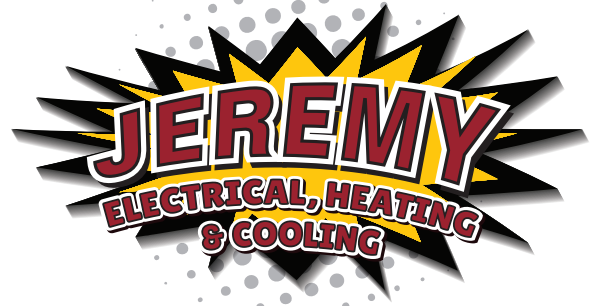


Grow Equipment Safety Checklist



Extension cord usage.

Often times people choose to get up and running with their equipment quickly by using extension cords that are only meant for temporary use. Extension cords can and will cause fire. Most of grow equipment will be considered a constant load being used often times anywhere from 12 hours to 16 hours to 24 hours a day. Permanent installation whether it be a receptacle or a controller box needs to be made from a source of power that can accommodate that demand. Often times it means running a new circuit from the electrical panel to the designated location.



Installing and properly terminating the correct size wiring and devices for your grow equipment.

Undersizing your wiring and poor connections can lead to a fire and or electrical shock.
